

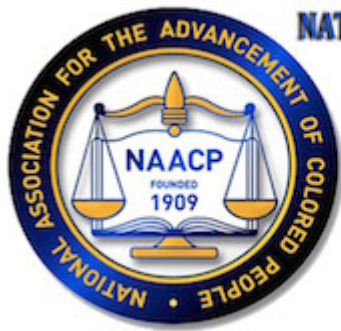

The North Carolina NAACP and the Forward Together Moral Movement will Hold a Press Conference to announce a Mass Moral Monday Memorial Vigil and Prayer Against Hate.

DURHAM, NC: On June 16th, the North Carolina NAACP, Forward Together Moral Movement and our Coalition Partners will gather at the NC NAACP State Office to announce the upcoming Moral Monday on June 20 at the North Carolina General Assembly and the Voting Rights Case that will be heading to U. S. Circuit Court of Appeals in Richmond Virginia on Tuesday June 21.

In the aftermath, of one of the deadliest and ugliest mass killing in our lifetime, and with our hearts heavy but hopes still high, we planning a vigil against hate and discrimination. Our Mass Moral Monday Vigil and Prayer Against Hate will be held this upcoming Monday, June 20

"We cannot let hate have the first, last or loudest word" said Rev. Dr. William J. Barber II, President of the NC NAACP.

The focus of this vigil will be the continued struggle against voter suppression, living wage suppression and hate towards the LGBTQ community.

"We will remember and honor all of those throughout history and most recently those who have suffered and sometimes died, because of discrimination and hate. We will recommit ourselves even more to love and justice, knowing this is the only way we can truly honor their lives" said Barber.
